This is an introductory, three-day course in which students will learn comparative anatomy of the horse, dog and cat. They will also be introduced to the powerful assessment tool of Myofascial Mapping, along with Integrative Diagnostics and treatment utilizing Integrative Manual Therapy (IMT). Neurofascial Process will be introduced for all animals.

Specific equine techniques include Basic Spinal Protocol, Myofascial Release, Joint Decompression, and General Visceral Fascial Releases. Canine techniques will address the ear and the hip. Feline techniques will focus on the Circulatory System. Lab times will give students the opportunity to practice these techniques on the respective animals with supervision and feedback. Practitioners will be able to easily apply these techniques on horses, dogs, and cats immediately following the successful completion of this course.
